GULL IDENTIFICATION SPECIAL

Saturday 31st January 2015

A day focussing on getting to grips with winter gulls in Pembrokeshire. As well as gaining confidence in identifying the 6 regular winter visitors, we will spend time learning to age them which will help demystify this small but challenging group. We may get lucky and add a couple of unusual species to our list! Whilst searching for gulls we will identify everything else we come across, so we can expect some 30-40 species in total if the weather is kind.



Morning – Gann Estuary (& Marloes Mere if time allows)

Afternoon – Llys-y-fran Reservoir, with a walk (approximately 3 miles in total) to the top end & back for woodland species)

You can book for morning or afternoon only, or spend the whole day with us (recommended).



Meet 9am at the Gann Estuary car park (SM808066) for the morning session

Meet 1pm at Llys-y-fran Reservoir (£2 charge applies, SM040244) for the afternoon session

Please bring a packed lunch if coming for the whole day. Please bring wellingtons and plenty of warm clothing – standing at Llys-y-fran for the gull roost can be particularly cold! Bring binoculars and a telescope and tripod if you have one.



Cost is just £40 for the whole day including return travel from Haverfordwest, £30 if providing your own transport, or £20 for half a day
